Since qualifying as an Occupational Therapist in 1996, Angela has worked in a variety of settings. Beginning her career on a mixed rotational post, giving her a good opportunity to get solid foundation in both physical and mental health care provision. Angela then progressed to specialise in Neurology becoming a senior OT in the Bradford Neurology Services both in community and inpatient care (1998-2000). She then became a senior in Neuro-rehabilitation at Rakehead Rehabilitation Centre which is a 17 bedded unit providing post-acute neuro-rehabilitation for highly complex neurologically impaired clients, mainly acquired brain injury (ABI) clients covering Lancashire and Cumbria region with a community service provision.

Angela worked there for 21 years and as the Senior Clinical Lead and Advanced Occupational Therapist for the last 13 years. During this time, she has been able to develop her extensive clinical skills in neuro- rehabilitation including ABI, she has wide-ranging post graduate training. Clinical skills training in such area as Normal movement (Boboth), cognitive rehabilitation, behavioural management, the assessment of clients with prolonged disorders of consciousness (PODC) including SMART assessor training, positioning and posture management including seating, wheelchair provision and posture in bed, housing, equipment and adaptations. Angela regularly provided brain injury rehabilitation and training for both patient, staff and families. She established many treatment programmes such as brain injury education programmes.

As a lead for the inpatient services, Angela managed the in-patient team so was responsible for staffing issues including recruitment of staff, holiday and sickness management, clinical governance and professional standards as well as the training needs of the whole multi-disciplinary team. She provided clinical support and training which enabled staff to have the treatment and assessment skills to be able to treat highly complex neurologically impaired clients as well as having an understanding of the impact this has on the wider family and their needs.
