EXPERIENCE

Francesca gained her Registered Nurse Post Graduate Diploma in 2016 and her Master's in Nursing Studies in 2019 both from the University of Southampton. She has been working as a Case Manager at AJ Case Management since 2020 throughout the South of England. Before becoming a Case Manager Francesca worked within the NHS as a Charge Nurse in a spinal treatment centre.

Francesca has a wide variety of experience within hospital and community settings working with Multi-Disciplinary Teams. She has specialist experience of spinal cord injury from her time as a ward leader at an NHS treatment centre. She also has extensive knowledge of the management of long-term conditions from her work as a community nurse, and from her experience working as a palliative nurse in a hospice. Throughout her work has included supporting people with traumatic and non-traumatic brain injuries, as well as with people with Cerebral Palsy.

Community nursing helped to develop her expertise for people who were living with complex conditions, in which she has always sought to improve their quality of life. Her Master's in Nursing Studies involved complex care, long term conditions, and even palliative care, which has helped her to create a "breaking down barriers" ethos to the ways in which healthcare and wellbeing is delivered.

She is driven to find innovative ways of working within the current healthcare structures of the UK for those living with complex needs. This has led her to present at the European Nurse Study Day for Spinal Cord Injury in Edinburgh in 2023, and the UK based national annual Guttman Conference for Spinal Cord Injury in Belfast in 2019. She has also been published in the Journal of Cardiac Nursing in 2020.

Her practice as a Case Manager is to be inclusive, finding ways to bring people together to support each other no matter what the complexities of a situation may be. Francesca has in-depth experience of working with people and their families who have sustained life changing injuries and illnesses. She works alongside the client and places them at the heart of their care.
