BIOGRAPHY

Ginny qualified as a nurse for people with learning disabilities in 1984, following this with roles in hospital and later community nursing, where she specialised in children and young people's care. Being offered an opportunity to set up a new residential service, Ginny worked to develop community based extra support for people with very complex needs. In turn this led to a role commissioning and managing community based supported living.

Ginny then spent a number of years in primary care, after she moved with her family to the Orkney Islands, firstly as a coordinator for diabetes, then stroke services in this remote and rural community. Her practice management skills and experience placed her in a key role as GP practice manager and then later to oversee all primary care for the Isles.

In 2008, Ginny took up a role with RNIB to lead their complex needs children's therapy services. This made best use of her experience in commissioning and recruiting a range of professionals and enabling them to work together in cohesive and collaborative teams. Ginny was later promoted to lead all of RNIB's Children and Young People's complex needs services across England. She has current experience in supporting very complex young people with a wide range of needs, including autism spectrum disorder, challenging behaviour, profound learning and physical disabilities, spina bifida and cerebral palsy. She has recent and valuable experience in sensory loss, specifically sight loss and vision impairments.

Ginny is experienced in therapy commissioning and recruitment and management of care staff. She has significant expertise in case work, leading multidisciplinary teams and health governance.
