BIOGRAPHY

Kate is a Registered Nurse in Learning Disability (formerly known as RNMH) and has worked with adults and children with learning disabilities in a variety of settings.

In her role as a case manager Kate has supported children, adults and their families in making arrangements that will enhance and promote independence. This has involved compiling assessment reports, ensuring support staff are recruited and trained appropriately. Kate is experienced in leading recruitment campaigns and planning for appropriate induction processes and supporting families as they take on the responsibility of employing others. Kate also has experience in multi-disciplinary working, developing support plans that are highly individualised, risk is known and managed which results in clients' being able to improve their plans and opportunities.

Kate's previous experience has all contributed to gaining skills and understanding that support her case management role. After qualifying in 1993 Kate worked as a community nurse with care management responsibility and also worked in a community home for people with learning disabilities and a mental illness.

Kate has set up and managed a new respite unit for adults who had cerebral palsy, hereditary or congenital conditions, neuro disabilities including acquired brain injury and learning disabilities. Alongside this Kate set up a domiciliary service supporting children and adults in their own homes. It was within this role that she started to gain experience in recruiting, training and managing staff, ensuring care packages met individual needs.

Kate worked with therapists, health colleagues, schools and colleges to ensure that all needs were known and correct equipment, staffing levels and protocols were in place. This was also Kate's first post in which she was a Registered Manager and had the responsibility of providing a service that families, local authorities, funders and regulatory bodies were confident met and exceeded their expectations and requirements.

Kate has also managed a respite service for children with profound learning and physical disabilities and associated health conditions. Although their needs were complex the emphasis was in providing fun activities on and off site, encouraging interests, hobbies and friendships. The children's health needs included managing 24-hour care for orthopaedic injury/trauma, pain management, positioning, carrying out therapy guidance, enteral feeds, secretion management as well as encouraging independence, communication and participating in the EHCP process and reviews. Kate worked closely with families ensuring that each child's needs were known, understood and all staff were trained and competent in being able to care for them.
