She has worked in both residential rehab and community settings at a senior level. In 2004, Anita joined WCM as a case manager, where she worked alongside her independent occupational therapy practice and also prepared expert witness reports. This combination of roles provided her with a strong understanding of the litigation process. Anita is experienced in setting up packages for rehabilitation and support in the community and in managing large teams of both agency and directly employed support workers. She has wide experience of working with challenging and non-compliant clients and has a passion for working with those who experience so called 'hidden injuries'.

In 2015, Anita assumed the position of clinical support manager at WCM and has since become the clinical lead. Her responsibilities in this role involve leading the clinical supervision, training and support for WCM case managers in their clinical practice. This includes conducting induction training for new case managers, facilitating peer support meetings, keeping them updated on changes to legislation and practice, providing mentoring support, and working closely with the company director to offer clinical guidance and ensure quality assurance. Anita embeds the BABICM competency framework into the practices at WCM.

Additionally, Anita delivers training on ABI and other case management related topics to individuals working in the field, particularly support workers and professionals in deputyship or litigation teams. Alongside her leadership role, Anita also takes on the role of case manager for a small number of clients. She thoroughly enjoys this work.
